We also use your data to maintain records about school visits for audience analysis purposes and report on our visitor numbers and our lawful basis for this processing is the Trust's legitimate interest in achieving the Museum's main charitable objective, which is to advance the education of the public in the history of mining.

You have the right to object to processing which is the Trust's legitimate interest.

We will keep your booking form for a year after your visit to the Museum, after which point the form will be shredded.

Your booking details will be digitally stored on our booking system for six years.

For financial records, we will securely retain details of your payments for six financial years following your visit.

You have the right to request that any inaccuracies in your data be put right, or your personal data erased.

If you have ticked the box agreeing to join our mailing list, in addition to the above we will send you regular e-newsletters (usually once a term) and occasionally printed flyers with news about upcoming events and activities, which are aimed at school groups.

You have the right to withdraw consent for us to contact you. We will retain a scanned copy of your booking form as a record of your consent to receive e-newsletters and we may contact you from time to time to renew your consent.
